Dear Camp Families,

We are praying that you have had a great school year so far and have had a wonderful start to 2019. Summer Camp is right around the corner and this year we will again be offering 9 weeks of camp fun. Please take time to read through this letter, including the back page for general camp information. Welcome to Bible Summer Camp 2019!

A Typical Camp Day...

Activities offered during Rotation Activity times will change depending on the day, and may include: gym time, arts and crafts, group games, video games, outside games (when the heat permits), or bouncy houses (in gym). Campers will go to the Rotation Activities with their assigned group.

Wednesday at camp is "Water Day". Water day activities include, water slides, slip 'n' slides and much more! Campers should bring their bathing suit, towel with their name, and sun screen/hat. They may bring EMPTY water toys to use during the water activities.

Thursdays are theme days. These days include crazy hair day, crazy hat day, dress-up day (pirate day, cowboy day, superhero day), etc.

Fridays are Movie Day. Campers will watch a movie on the big screen in the church!

Birthday Celebrations We love to celebrate birthdays! You may bring treats to share.

Lunches: Campers must bring their own lunch. Refrigerator and microwave are not available for camper use. All lunches must be labeled with the camper's first and last name and grade. Individual pizzas from Pizza Hut may be pre-purchased by Wednesday for the following Friday, and cost \$5. Pizza order forms will be available at check-in and check-out.

Snack & Snack Bar: A morning snack is provided for free and may include crackers, pretzels, veggies, fruit, etc. and water or lemonade. In the afternoon campers can purchase items in the snack bar such as juice boxes, fruit snacks, assorted candies and cookies, and Gatorade. All items are \$.50. Please note that \$1.00 is enough to get a camper a drink and a treat, so please do not send more than a couple of dollars. If your camper is restricted as to what they can purchase, please inform the camper's counselor.

Before & After Care: Before care is available from 7:30 am to 8:45am for \$5/day per child. After care is available from 3:20 pm to 5:15 pm also for \$5. Campers MUST be picked up by 5:15 pm. Before and after care is located in the Fellowship Hall after 6/10/19.

Early Pick-Up: If your child needs to be picked up early, please let your child's counselor know what time they are to be picked up during sign-in. To pick up your camper, please come to the church office. If your child is being picked up by someone other than their parents or legal guardian please request a release form that can be provided at the time of sign-in. A release form is required prior to the day that your child will be picked up if they are going home with a friend.

Drop-Off & Pick-Up: Campers not in Before Care can be dropped off as early as 8:45 am. Sign-in is located at the front of the church. If your child is dropped off before 8:45 am, they will go to Before Care and you will be charged \$5/day per child. Pick up is from 3:00 pm to 3:20pm in the gym. If your child is not picked up by 3:20 pm they will go to After Care in Fellowship Hall and you will be charged \$5/day per child.

Bringing Valuable Items: Camp is a fun and exciting experience. In this environment items tend to become misplaced or switch hands. In light of this, we request that the following or any similar possessions be left at home: electronic devices, iPods, iPads, cell phones, gaming devices, trading cards, etc.

Lost & Found: In order to easily keep track of your camper's personal items, we ask that all items are clearly marked with your child's first and last name as well as their fall 2019 grade.


Registration Due Dates: Registration fees are due by the Friday of the preceding week. For example: fees for Power Up!, June3-7, are due on Friday May 31st.

Refunds: Refunds will only be issued if notice of cancelation is submitted by the Friday of the preceding week. For example: Fees paid for Rolling River Rampage, June 4-8, will only be refunded if notice of cancelation is received by June 1st.


Rollover/Credit of Funds: Paid registration fees will not be rolled over to future weeks of camp. For example, if your child is registered for 5 days of one week, but only attends for 4 days, the daily registration fee will not be credited to a future balance. If you know in advance that your child will not attend all 5 days of any week then you may opt to register your child on a daily basis for \$30/day. The daily rate of \$30/day applies no matter what date you first registered for camp.
